



Simple Time Rhythm Part 4 -

In simple time **semiquavers** look like this when grouped in fours  and like this  when on their own. Individually this note lasts for one quarter of a beat therefore a group of four will last for one beat (you will hear four equal sounds on a beat). The rhythm name for a group of four semiquavers is **tika-tika**.

In simple time a **semiquaver rest** is a silence that lasts for one quarter of a beat.

Read the rhythm of this example using the rhythm names while tapping or conducting the beat.


